## Mud Pie Puddle Party with Dena Ann Adams – Supply List

- Tube Watercolors I used a set by Sakura Koi. Don't spend a lot here or use your best paints if you're trying to conserve them!
- 1 inch flat wash brush
- medium watercolor or sumi-e brush (size 12-20 round)
- White fine point Uni Posca pen
- Black Tombow brush marker (if you want to try some hand lettering as I have)
- detail brush (10/0 or 20/0 optional but nice to have)
- White ink (acrylic or water-reactivated) Higgins, PhMartins, FW all are fine
- Dropper or Pipette (optional but nice)
- Paper Towels
- Water container and water
- Glue (Mod Podge is fine)
- Scissors
- Palette I use a cheap cermic plate, wax paper or plastic palettes are fine. If you use acrylic ink, use wax paper and/or clean your palette right away.
- Canson XL paper 11x15, 3 sheets. Cheap 140 pound Watercolor paper of your choice is great.
