Materials SUPPLIES

- Air-dry clay (I'm using Active Plus, Terra Cotta)
- Adhesive (I prefer hot glue, but craft glue or super glue works)
- Beads (colors of your choice):
- size 8/0 seed beads (12 total; I used one color)
- size 6/0 seed beads (54–84, depending on size; I used three colors)
- 6mm faceted rondelle beads (6 total)
- Beading thread (I like Beadalon Wildfire .006)
- Hemp cord, 10# or 20# (I love Hemptique brand)
- Jump rings, large/6–8mm, 2 (additional smaller jump rings to adjust size are optional)
- Magnetic clasp
- Water dish and water

TOOLS

- Clay tools: roller, cutting blade, scratch awl or needle tool
- Stamp(s) (for texture), rubber or hand-carved (optional)
- Beading mat (optional)
- Binder clip, large-ish (for securing work to loom)
- "Big Eye" beading needle
- Dust mask (optional)
- Fine-grit sanding sponge (I love the Sanding Pad "Step 3" 220 grit by Ace)
- Jewel Loom ("Original" size) <u>https://www.jewelloom.com/jewelshop</u>
- Jewelry pliers (flat-nose and bent chain-nose)
- Scissors
