UPPLIES USED THIS SESSION

Please note, below are the supplies I used, but you can substitute the supplies if and where needed if you don't have what I've used.


- 1 Sheet of hotpressed watercolour paper (140lbs) (I used 16 x 12" but you can use 12×9 " if you prefer).
- Watercolour paints (I used Schmincke but any brand will do).
- Posca pens black and white (or other waterproof black/ white pens).
- ◆ Watercolour brushes (round, 1 large, 1 medium).
- A tool for etching/ scribbling like a bamboo skewer or an old knitting needle.

Colour Scheme I worked in today:

Analogous with a bit of a Complement in orange/ yellow-orange/magenta & indigo

(But feel free to choose other colours if they resonate more for you!)

ANALOGOUS - COMPLEMENTARY



Simple steps to creating a beautiful watercolour feather.

- 1. Draw or trace your feather.
- 2. Add colour to your feather either using a wet in wet technique or wet on dry technique.
- 3. Use your bamboo skewer to 'draw' hair strands.
- 4. Add drips to make the painting more playful.
- 5. Write uplifting messages/ words/ quotes inside and outside the feather if you feel called to.

Be gentle with yourself and try to approach this playfully, enjoying the process and avoid focusing on the outcome.















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
